

May the Star Wars Force NEVER Be with You

The 'Force' talked about in the Star Wars movies is actually a collection of nasty evil spirits who want to invade your soul (mind, will and emotions) and take up residence. If you watch a Star Wars movie and seek to do the things that the Jedi do, then you will be a prey to these evil spirits. This article explains the wolf behind the sheep's clothing.

Hollywood is promoting Rosicrucian occultism

Star Wars and many movies today are promoting some of the core occultic practices of the Ancient Mystical Order Rosae Crucis (AMORC), a.k.a.

Rosicrucianism, which is openly hostile to Christianity and fundamental Bible teachings on God, Christ and salvation. It's basically about DIY spiritual transformation

based on Egyptian religions, Hinduism, kabbalah and Gnosticism. Rosicrucians use mental techniques to actualize their focused thoughts of health, prosperity, peace and happiness. They also believe in reincarnation and evolved spiritual masters, which are actually fallen angels. Rosicrucians are alleged to take part in the following occult practices:

- Necromancy, which is talking to familiar spirits who impersonate dead people (and is expressly forbidden in Deuteronomy 18:11).**
- Telepathy, which is transmitting information from one person to another without using any known human sensory channels or physical interaction.**
- Telekinesis, which is causing motion in objects without contact or other physical means**
- Psychic (or astral) projection, which is an intentional out-of-body experience in which a person's soul or consciousness (called an "astral**

body”) separates from his or her physical body so as to travel to another place.

Hollywood is stirring up rebellion

Like many Hollywood movies, Star Wars portrays the ruling power as absolutely evil and only worthy of being rebelled against and resisted. However, in real life we know from the Bible that God Almighty establishes all authority to accomplish His purposes, so to join the wicked in trying to “throw off their chains” (Psalm 2:3) is rebellion against God Almighty and will result in His judgment (Romans 13:1-5). In fact, God Almighty even laughs at rebels (Psalm 2:4). There are no rebels in the Kingdom of God Almighty. Rebels are actually serving the worldly kingdom of Lucifer, the first angel who rebelled against God Almighty (Isaiah 14:12-15 and Ezekiel 28:11-19). Hollywood glorifies rebellion, but in fact it is like witchcraft, and stubbornness is like idolatry (1 Samuel

15:23). King Saul found this out the hard way, as he lost the spirit of God Almighty and gained an evil spirit after he rebelled by not doing exactly as God Almighty told him to do in battle. (See 1 Samuel 15.)

Hollywood ignores the Biblical standard of sin

Like many Hollywood movies, Star Wars portrays the rebel heroes as mostly virtuous with only minor flaws. However, the Bible says that we are all sinners and fall short of the glory of God (Romans 3:23), and all our righteous acts are like filthy menstrual rags if they are not done in service to the Lord Jesus Christ (Isaiah 64:6). Actually, anything not done out of faith in Jesus Christ is sin (Romans 14:23), so we certainly don't want to emulate the heroes of Star Wars movies. Jesus Christ said, "That which is exalted among men is an abomination before God." (Luke 16:15)
