


Beast-free Certification Examination

Avoiding the Mark of the 7-headed Beast has become the final examination of this life. It includes several parts, and it will not be easy for anybody to pass. Certification for passing all the parts means that the Lord Jesus Christ will not erase the person's name from the Book of Life (Revelation 3:5). The penalty for failing is eternal torment in the Lake of Fire (Revelation 14:9-11; 20:15). If a person wants to pass all parts, he or she will be wise to study all the following Scripture, pray about it, believe it, and obey it.

Appreciation test

- The person must demonstrate a basic appreciation God's perfect and beautiful design of his or her body, including the innate and adaptive immune system and DNA.
- This includes refraining from any modification to the immune system or DNA, since a person's DNA uniquely identifies him or her and provides authentication for entry into Heaven or entry to Beast-controlled premises or countries.

Conformity test

- The person must demonstrate a healthy desire to not be conformed this world.
- This includes not going along with the crowd or peers in order to get along.

Suffering test

- The person must demonstrate a good understanding of God's purpose for giving suffering and testing.
- This includes accepting suffering and testing caused by circumstances.
- Deuteronomy 8:2-6; Proverbs 3:12; Acts 14:22; Romans 5:3,4; 8:16-18; Hebrews 12:5,6; James 1:2-4; 1 Peter 1:6,7; 2:20-23; 4:1-5; Revelation 3:19



Praise test

- The person must desire the praise of God more than the praise of men.
- This includes demonstrating the ability to obey God rather than men.
- It may also include getting excluded from certain groups.
- Matthew 25:14-30; John 5:41,44; 12:42,43; Acts 5:29; 1 Thessalonians 2:3-5



Reputation test

- The person must demonstrate a willingness to lose face, lose others' respect, lose a good reputation, and suffer persecution for Christ Jesus.
- This includes losing certain things that most people hold dear, like job security, standard of living, access rights to certain venues, and a large social network.
- Matthew 13:20,21; 1 Corinthians 1:24-31; 2 Corinthians 12:10; Galatians 6:12; Philippians 3:7,8; Hebrews 13:12-14



Faith test

- The person must demonstrate the ability to walk by faith and not by sight.
- This includes trusting the Lord Jesus Christ to provide food and lodging and other needs.
- Romans 1:17; 10:3,4; 2 Corinthians 5:7



Martyr test

- The person must be willing to die for the cause of Christ and to retain one's God-given DNA.
- This is most likely the final test for those who are still in smart cities when persecution starts.
- Daniel 7:21; Matthew 24:12,13; Luke 9:23-25; Philippians 1:21; Revelation 12:11,17



- Those who have gone into exile prior to the start of persecution may not need to take this test, although they need to be willing to die too. They must also be active in preaching about the Lord Jesus Christ and their faith in Him so that He desires to keep them alive.
- Proverbs 22:3; Daniel 12:7; 2 Chronicles 11:13,14; Matthew 24:14-22; Acts 8:1-4
